



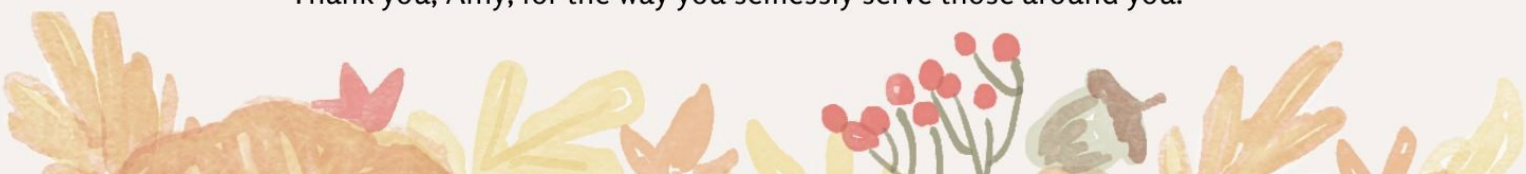
Fall Time at **S.O.A.R**
